RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR HOUSE BILL 54.30 EXPANSION OF THE STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION TAX CREDIT

Whereas historic preservation is of great importance to the citizens of Michigan and the Michigan Archaeological Society; and

Whereas the financial incentive the State Historic Tax Credit Program provides is often a critical success factor in historic preservation; and

Whereas expansion of the tax credit incentive currently authorized by the State Historic Tax Credit Program is expected to significantly increase the amount of historic preservation that can be achieved.

Now be it therefore resolved that the Michigan Archaeological Society, a statewide organization composed of avocational and professional archaeologists, educators, students, local historians, community leaders and Michigan citizens in all walks of life who have an active interest in the past, expresses our strong support for House Bill 54.30 which expands the tax credit in the State Historic Tax Credit Program in order that the interests of all Michigan residents be better served, because Michigan's past belongs to all of us.
