Dear Friend of Michigan Preservation:

The Michigan Historic Preservation Network (MHPN) invites you to contribute an item to our silent and live auctions to be held at our 30th Annual Fall Benefit in October. MHPN is *the* membership organization in Michigan dedicated to recognizing and preserving the state's architectural and cultural heritage. Your item, when auctioned, provides financial support for our efforts.

THE EVENT: This year we're in Adrian, a town of just over 20,000 residents, serving as the Lenawee County seat since 1838. Its rich history is reflected in its historic downtown, neighborhoods, and civic buildings listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Our venue – the Adrian Armory – was built between 1924-1925. Tudor in styling, the masonry Armory has an imposing entrance framed by turrets and battlement.
